

RESOLUTION NO. 98-31

**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY
COUNCIL APPROVING AN INCREASE TO
THE ANIMAL CONTROL BUDGET IN THE
AMOUNT OF \$4,000 TO OFF-SET
EXPENDITURES**

WHEREAS, the City collects mandatory spay and neuter deposit funds when animals are adopted out of the Animal Shelter under CA Food and Agricultural Code 31751 and,

WHEREAS, throughout the year these funds go unclaimed and are placed into a deferred revenue account to be applied to: Public Education Program, spay and neuter programs, follow up programs, additional costs incurred under this section and,

WHEREAS, the City has entered into a cooperative agreement with the IWW Humane Society to carry out program above.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest does hereby approve an increase to the Animal Control Budget in the amount of \$4,000.00 to off-set expenditures.
