

RESOLUTION NO. 98-32

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST AWARDING TOM FRISBEE THE COMMERCIAL PROJECT OF THE QUARTER AWARD FOR FIRST QUARTER 1998 FOR FACADE IMPROVEMENTS AT 217 NORTH BALSAM STREET, CONTINUED INVESTMENT IN THE COMMUNITY AND RECOGNITION AS ONE OF THE TOP 100 BICYCLE SHOPS IN AMERICA.
