**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL
AWARDING BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT (BLM) THE
COMMERCIAL PROJECT OF THE QUARTER AWARD FOR THE
SECOND QUARTER 1998 FOR PROMOTING TOURISM AND
