

RESOLUTION NO. 98-72

**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY
COUNCIL APPROVING THE EXTENSION OF
THE APPOINTMENT OF JOHN STERLING AS
INTERIM CITY ADMINISTRATOR**

WHEREAS, John Sterling was appointed as Interim City Administrator in March of 1998 to fill the vacancy left by Ken Kelley; and

WHEREAS, this interim period was initially set for 90 days, but allowing for extensions; and

WHEREAS, the 90 day period has expired, and the City has hired an independent firm for the recruitment of a permanent City Administrator, with a predicted time frame not to exceed January 1999; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to retain John Sterling in the position of Interim City Administrator until such time as a permanent City Administrator is hired.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the appointment of John Sterling to the position of Interim City Administrator is extended until such time as the Council appoints a permanent City Administrator.




