

**RESOLUTION NO. 98-76**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST SETTING THE PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS FOR "UNMET NEEDS" IN THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM**

**WHEREAS**, during each year the City of Ridgecrest receives rural federal transit assistance under several sources of funding; Transportation Development Act Funds (TDA) , Federal Transit Administration funds (FTA), and passenger fare revenues. Additionally, the City of Ridgecrest receives capital grant assistance funds from the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Program.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest does hereby resolve as follows:

Section 1. The Public Hearing to hear comments and recommendations for "unmet needs" in public transportation in the City of Ridgecrest and surrounding areas covered under a Joint Powers Agreement (JPA) with the County of Kern is hereby set for Wednesday, September 16, 1998 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers.


