

RESOLUTION NO. 98-86

A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY TO CO-SPONSOR AN APPLICATION TO THE SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE FOR ASSISTANCE IN PLANNING AND CARRYING OUT A PROGRAM OF ACTION TO BE KNOWN AS THE MOJAVE DESERT-MOUNTAIN RESOURCE CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS a resource conservation and development project helps to bring about a better place for people to live, work, and play, and create a base for new jobs, higher incomes, outdoor recreation, and beautification of the countryside, and:

WHEREAS the United States Department of Agriculture, by authority of the Food and Agriculture Act of 1962, gives technical and financial help to local groups in the conservation and development of natural resources in their area and assists project sponsors, seek funds and services from other federal agencies and from state and local sources and;

WHEREAS resource conservation and development project's our sponsored by local groups such as county boards of supervisors, towns, Cities, resource conservation districts, Indian tribal councils, and other special purpose districts, and;

WHEREAS the City of Ridgecrest has a policy of cooperating with other units of government and public organizations for the common good of its citizens.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City of Ridgecrest will co-sponsor an application to the Secretary of Agriculture under the terms of the Food and Agriculture Act of 1962 for assistance in planning and carrying out a program of action to be known as the Mojave Desert-Mountain Resource Conservation and Development Project.


