

RESOLUTION NO. 98-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY
COUNCIL APPROVING STAFF NEGOTIATIONS WITH
PURKISS-ROSE-RSI OF FULLERTON, CALIFORNIA
FOR THE DESIGN OF A SKATEBOARD PARK.

NOW THEREFORE, THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY
RESOLVE as follows:

- Section 1. The Skateboard Park Committee (Councilman Ronald Carter, City Administrator Kenneth Kelley, Parks and Recreation Director William Bersie, Ridgecrest Youth Advisory Members Chrissy Beavis and Brian Cosgrove) conducted interviews with two (2) landscape architecture firms on January 17, 1998.
- Section 2. By unanimous vote, the Committee recommends negotiations be opened with the firm: Purkiss-Rose-RSI of Fullerton, California.
- Section 3. The Ridgecrest City Council approves staff request to negotiate with Purkiss-Rose-RSI of Fullerton, California for the design of a skateboard park.


