

RESOLUTION NO. 98-95

A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING FUNDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF A VEHICLE FOR POLICE AND COMMUNITY TOGETHER (P.A.C.T.)

WHEREAS, the police department has solicited open competitive request to supply the police department with vehicles and,

WHEREAS, the police department desires to continue assisting P.A.C.T. in purchasing a reliable vehicle to transport juveniles and property/evidence to Bakersfield and back and,

WHEREAS, Police and Community Together (P.A.C.T.) has received donated funds to cover the remaining cost of the purchase of the vehicle,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest does hereby approve a budget increase to the AB 3229 Budget (Fund 063) in the amount of \$ 12,000 to be provided to P.A.C.T. To purchase a reliable new vehicle to serve the City. The funds are provided with the understanding that the vehicle will become property of the City and covered by City liability insurance.


