

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-103**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL  
APPROVING CITY SPONSORSHIP OF A 100 VOICES  
CONFERENCE**

**WHEREAS**, a 100 Voices Conference has been an excellent vehicle for discussion of youth ideas and needs in this community. An earlier conference lead to the formation of the Youth Advisory Committee, the development of ideas for the skate park, and other youth activities; and

**WHEREAS**, another 100 Voices Conference is being planned for February of 2000. The conference will provide an opportunity to build on the accomplishments of the 1997 conference and hear from a new group of voices in the dynamic youth community of Ridgecrest, and

**WHEREAS**, young bodies and young minds need nourishment and the conference provides that in the form of refreshments and a meal at the conference. The cost of the meal is about \$700 for the crowd expected. Members of the Quality of Life Committee are leading an effort to raise that money in the local community, but the committee would like the Council to be ready to insure the success of the conference by pledging to supplement whatever fundraising has been accomplished by the committee.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council authorizes the expenditure of up to \$700 to sponsor the 100 Voices Conference meals.
