

RESOLUTION NO. 99-105

**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL
DIRECTING STAFF TO PLAN A BICYCLE EVENT FOR
OCTOBER 2000**

WHEREAS, The Bicycle Events conducted on October 23, 1999 were considered a success. The entertainment attracted a crowd of 300-400 people and more than 60 young people were entered in the bicycle safety rodeo; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to build on the success of the first event by beginning planning for an even better event next year. Booking entertainment and arranging schedules requires that planning begin as soon as possible and funding commitments be made to secure the entertainment, such as the Gale Webb Show which was so well received, and

WHEREAS, volunteers from the community made the event possible. An even better event next year will require even more volunteers. The event is definitely too large to be handled by City staff alone , and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council directs the City Administrator to begin planning for the bicycle events for next year including required deposits to book the entertainment as necessary. If budget adjustments are required to fund part of the expense during the current fiscal year, bring those budget adjustments to the Council for approval. Work with the community to locate an organization and a number of volunteers to assist the City.




