

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-83**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL  
APPROVING THE DISABILITY RETIREMENT OF ARTHUR A.  
HUFFMAN**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Ridgecrest, hereinafter referred to as Agency, is a contracting agency of the Public Employee's Retirement System; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Employee's Retirement Law requires that a contracting agency determine whether a local safety member employee is disabled for purposes of the Public Employee's Retirement Law; and

**WHEREAS**, an application for disability retirement of Arthur A. Huffman employed by the Agency in the position of Police Officer has been filed with the Public Employee's Retirement System; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has reviewed the medical and other evidence relevant to such alleged disability.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council does hereby find and determine that Arthur A. Huffman is incapacitated within the meaning of the Public Employee's Retirement Law for performance of his duties in the position of Police Officer.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A PETITION** has been filed with the Worker's Compensation Appeals Board for a determination pursuant to Section 21166, Government Code; and a copy of such determination will be provided when rendered; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the member will be separated from his employment in the position of Police Officer after the expiration of his leave rights under Section 21164, Government Code, effective September 22, 1999 and that no dispute as to the expiration of such leave rights is pending. There is not a possibility of third party liability.

Advanced Disability Pension payments will be made. The payments will be made monthly in the amount of \$1206.56 beginning October 8, 1999.

The primary disabling condition is psychological in nature. The member is competent to act on his own behalf in legally binding retirement matters.

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The member's disabling condition is not a direct consequence of a violent act perpetuated upon the member's person nor did it occur during the performance of those portions of the member's duties, which are particularly hazardous and dangerous.


