**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL  
APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE TRONA JOINT  
UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR DARE PROGRAM SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Ridgecrest provides DARE Officer services to the Sierra Sands School District, and

**WHEREAS**, the City's DARE program is recognized as highly beneficial to those students participating in the program and; and

**WHEREAS**, the Trona Joint Unified School District has requested participation in the City's DARE Program; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Ridgecrest Police Department has determined that such services could be provided without causing a reduction in DARE Program services within the Ridgecrest Schools; and that DARE program services to the Trona Joint Unified School District would be beneficial to the City of Ridgecrest by reducing the incidences of drug and resulting undesirable consequences of drug use in the Ridgecrest area ,

**WHEREAS**, the City Council, at this time, concurs with the Police Department assessment;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Ridgecrest City Council that the City Administrator is hereby authorized to sign the attached contract with the Trona Joint Unified School District for DARE program services:





**CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES**

City of Ridgecrest, hereinafter called City, and the Trona Joint Unified School District, hereinafter called District, hereby agree as follows:

1. City agrees to provide professional services and materials required to furnish DARE Program Services at the Trona Elementary School and to complete said services during the second semester of the 1999-2000 school year.
2. City and District each agree to hold the other harmless from any loss, damage or injury arising from the performance of service.
3. District shall compensate the City the total sum of \$4,340.39 for all services rendered.
4. District shall pay City within 30 days after completion of service and presentation of an appropriate invoice.


