

RESOLUTION NO. 00-105

**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL
DECLARING ITS COMMITMENT TO DESIGNATING THE
NAWS GOLF COURSE IRRIGATION AS HIGHEST
PRIORITY FOR THE TARGETED EFFLUENT RE-USE**

WHEREAS, on December 9, 1974, the City of Ridgecrest (contractor) entered into a "Negotiated Sewer Service Contract" with the United States of America, Department of the Navy, Naval Weapons Center, China Lake, (government); and,

WHEREAS, Government reserved the right to utilize 750 acre feet of treated effluent per year for irrigation of the golf course located upon government property at the service location; and

WHEREAS, small portions of the treated effluent is dedicated to sustain environmentally sensitive wetland habitat; and

WHEREAS, the golf course is considered one of the highest community assets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest that after meeting the obligation to sustain the wetland habitat, dedication of the effluent to maintain the golf course is the highest priority.


