

RESOLUTION NO. 00-108

**A RESOLUTION FOR THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL
SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER
COMMENTS TO ALLOW THE CALIFORNIA VEHICLE
CODE TO BE ENFORCED ON PRIVATELY OWNED
ROADWAYS WITHIN THE CITY.**

WHEREAS, the California Vehicle Code authorizes the City Council to enact a resolution that will allow enforcement of the vehicle code upon private roadways within the city, and;

WHEREAS, the property owners of the housing developments know as Sierra Village Apartments and Gold Canyon Apartments, and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Heritage Village Master Community Association has requested enforcement of the vehicle code within their private housing developments, and;

WHEREAS, before the council may enact a resolution allowing the enforcement of the vehicle code on private roadways a public hearing must be held to hear comments and recommendations from the property owners of the private roadways and from the public.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Ridgecrest City Council that the Public Hearing to hear comments and recommendations for the consideration of allowing vehicle code enforcement on private roadways within housing developments known as Sierra Village Apartments, Gold Canyon Apartments, and Heritage Village Master Community is hereby set for Wednesday, November 1, 2000 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers.


