

**RESOLUTION NO. 00-124**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL AMENDING  
THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FIVE YEAR PLAN  
AND AUTHORIZING STAFF TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR PROGRAM  
YEAR 2001-2002 PROJECTS**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest has through the HUD mandated public hearing process identified the community development needs for the long range planning purposes of the Community Development Block Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Ridgecrest has elected to participate in the Community Development Block Grant Program as administered by Kern County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Community Development Block Grant program's primary objective is to assist in the development of viable urban communities and these projects proposed by the City of Ridgecrest will meet the criteria established by Congress of:

- (a) an activity that will alleviate existing conditions which pose a serious and immediate threat to the health and welfare of the community and must have developed or become critical within the past 18 months;
- (b) aid in the prevention or elimination of slums or blight; and/or
- (c) principally benefit persons of low or moderate income;

**NOW THEREFORE THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL HEREBY** amends the "five Year Plan" as presented and authorizes staff to make application to the Community Development Block Grant Program for the Sunset Street Improvement project identified to be completed for the 2001-2002 Community Development program year and authorizes staff to request an advance against the City's 2002-2003 fair share allocation of up to \$100,000.00 to be applied to the Sunset Street Improvement project,


