**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL  
REQUESTING KERN COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT  
TO REALLOCATE CDBG FUNDING FROM CD ACTIVITY  
#17.98.4 (ABATEMENT OF DILAPIDATED STRUCTURES) TO  
CD ACTIVITY #17.98.3 (SKATE PARK IMPROVEMENTS)**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest elected to participated in the Kern County Community Development Block Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kern County Board of Supervisors did approve the City of Ridgecrest's application to construct the above named projects under the Community Development Block Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS**, CD activity #17.98.4 (Abatement of Dilapidated Structures) is no longer a viable project because the facilities scheduled for abatement were subsequently found to contain asbestos which greatly increased the cost of demolition and actions on the part of the property owner have caused the property to go into litigation over abatement issues; and

**WHEREAS**, the low bid for CD Activity #17.98.3 (Skate Park Improvements) was significantly over budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest conducted a public hearing on May 3, 2000 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers to hear comments and recommendations on the proposed reallocation of CDBG project funds from CD activity 17.98.4 (Abatement of Dilapidated Structures) to CD activity 17.98.3 (Skate Park Improvements) Wednesday,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest hereby requests Kern County Community Development to reallocate CDBG funding from CD activity #17.98.4 (Abatement of Dilapidated Structures) to CD activity #17.98.3 (Skate Park Improvements)

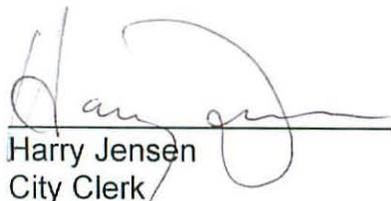
