

RESOLUTION NO. 00-80

A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT, ARTICLE 3 FUNDS FOR FY 2000-2001 GRANTS FOR THE FOLLOWING PROJECTS:

- **UPJOHN AVE. BICYCLE LANE FROM DOWNS ST. TO NORMA ST.**
- **LEROY JACKSON PARK BICYCLE LANE**
- **UPJOHN AVE. PEDESTRIAN WALKWAY COMPLETION FROM CHINA LAKE BLVD. TO NORMA ST.**
- **LAS FLORES AVE. PEDESTRIAN WALKWAY COMPLETION FROM CHINA LAKE BLVD. TO NORMA ST.**

WHEREAS, the Kern Council of Governments has announced a funding opportunity for Transportation and Development Act, Article 3, non-motorized transportation projects for the FY 2000-2001 program year. Applications are due at Kern COG by August 1, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the application contains assurances that the applicant must comply with; and

WHEREAS, the applicant, if selected, will enter into an agreement with the Kern Council of Governments to carry out the agreed upon Improvements projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED that the Ridgecrest City Council:

- (1) Approves the filing of an application for the Transportation and Development Act, Article 3, FY 2000-2001 grant program for consideration for funding.
- (2) Certifies that said applicant will make adequate provisions for operation and maintenance of the projects.
- (3) Appoints the City Administrator as agent of the City of Ridgecrest to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to application, agreements, amendments, payment request and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned projects.
