

RESOLUTION NO. 00-85

**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL
APPROVING THE CONTRACT TO TETRA TECH FOR
GROUND WATER MONITORING**

WHEREAS, the Regional Water Quality Control Board (Lahontan) has expanded its ground water monitoring and testing and due to the technical nature of the testing, the City needs to seek outside assistance to complete the required monitoring and hydrology reports; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest sent out requests for proposals to several firms, listing the scope of work to be done; and

WHEREAS, the City received two (2) bids - one from Papros, Inc. for \$21,230 and one from Tetra Tech for \$13,037.23, Tetra Tech being the lowest bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ridgecrest City Council award a three (3) year contract to Tetra Tech for the required monitoring and hydrology reports to be sent to the Regional Water Quality Control Board (Lahontan).


