**A RESOLUTION FOR THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL  
SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER  
COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS FOR  
PROJECTS TO BE CONSIDERED IN THE LOCAL LAW  
ENFORCEMENT BLOCK GRANT**

**WHEREAS**, the Bureau of Justice Assistance, Office of Justice Programs, United States Department of Justice through the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant allows a direct grant award, and

**WHEREAS**, \$24,530.00 is the direct grant award for the 2002 Grant Period, and

**WHEREAS**, this direct grant award requires a ten percent (10%) match of city funds of \$2,726.00, and

**WHEREAS**, the total block grant project is \$27,256.00, and

**WHEREAS**, before grant funds can be obligated and expended a public hearing must be held to hear comments and recommendations from the public for projects to be included in grant funding.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Ridgecrest City Council that the Public Hearing to hear comments and recommendations for projects to be included in the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant funding is hereby set for Wednesday, September 18, 2002 at 6:00 p.m., or soon thereafter, in the City Council Chambers.




