

RESOLUTION NO. 02 -113

A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING THE 2002-03 OVERALL DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISES GOAL OF ELEVEN PERCENT (11%) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TRANSMIT THE REQUIRED DOCUMENTS TO THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, that certain document entitled City of Ridgecrest Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) Program was approved on July 20, 2001, as the policy of the City of Ridgecrest to utilize DBEs in all aspects of contracting to the maximum extent feasible in connection with program activities funded wholly or in part by the U.S. Department of Transportation Federal Aid Funds; and

WHEREAS, the DBE policy must be reviewed and updated by City Council annually; and

WHEREAS, using the methodology set forth by the California Department of Transportation (CalTrans), the Public Works Director calculated the overall DBE goal to be 11% for Federal Fiscal Year 2002-03, from October 1, 2002 to September 30, 2003; and

WHEREAS, CalTrans reviewed and approved the draft overall DBE goal of 11% and this overall DBE goal has been published in local newspapers and minority publications and no comments were received.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest does hereby adopt the 2002-03 Overall Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) Goal of eleven percent (11%) and authorizes the City Manager to transmit the required documents to the California Department of Transportation.




