RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS FOR THE HAZARD ELIMINATION SAFETY (HES) PROGRAM UNDER SECTION 152 (a), TITLE 23, UNITED STATES CODE (U.S.C.) FOR THE FOLLOWING PROJECTS:

Traffic Signal, Ridgecrest Boulevard. and Gold Canyon Drive
Traffic Signal, Rader Avenue and China Lake Boulevard.
Traffic Signal, Upjohn Avenue and China Lake Boulevard
Street Lighting, French Avenue and Drummond Avenue
Street Lighting, Norma Street, Las Flores Avenue, Drummond Avenue

WHEREAS, the United States Congress has enacted the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century of 1998 requires that ten percent of the apportioned Surface Transportation Program (STP) funds be made available for safety programs as defined by Section 152 – Hazard Elimination Program of Title 23, United States Code; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation has established the procedures and criteria for reviewing proposals and is required to submit to the California Department of Transportation Commission a list of recommended projects from which the recipients will be selected; and

WHEREAS, the applicant, if selected, will enter into an agreement with the State of California to carry out the transportation enhancement activities project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED that the Ridgecrest City Council:

- (1) Approves the filing of an application for Hazard Elimination Program for consideration for funding.
- (2) Certifies that said applicant will make adequate provisions for operation and maintenance of the project.




