

RESOLUTION NO. 02-121

A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL FOR AN EXEMPTION TO THE PURCHASING POLICY (RESOLUTION 89-120, SECTION 10) FOR AN OPEN PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR FY03 NOT TO EXCEED \$10,000 BETWEEN JIM CHARLON FORD AND THE CITY OF RIDGECREST FOR FACTORY DIRECT TRANSIT BUS PARTS

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest is responsible for the Ridgecrest Transit System and all repair and maintenance of the buses; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest Resolution 89-120, Section 10, requires that purchases of \$5,000 - \$10,000 shall be based on at least three (3) competitive bids and be approved by Council; and

WHEREAS, Jim Charlon Ford is the only vendor who offers factory direct parts.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES and authorizes an open purchase agreement for FY03 in the amount of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) for the purchase of factory direct transit bus parts from Jim Charlon Ford.




