

RESOLUTION NO. 02-125

**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL
APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS FOR
THE LIGHT EMITTING DIODE TRAFFIC SIGNALS PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the California Energy Commission provides grants to finance energy efficiency projects that will reduce peak electricity demand; and

WHEREAS, the applicant, if selected, will enter into an agreement with the California Energy Commission to carry out the Light Emitting Diode Traffic Signals project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ridgecrest City Council authorizes the City Manager to apply for funding from the California Energy Commission to replace incandescent traffic signals with those using light emitting diodes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if recommended for a funding award by the California Energy Commission, the Ridgecrest City Council authorizes the City of Ridgecrest to accept a grant up to \$18,950.00; and

That the City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of City of Ridgecrest all necessary documents to implement and carry out the purpose of this resolution, and to undertake all actions necessary to undertake and complete the energy efficiency project.




