**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL  
ESTABLISHING A FOUR WAY STOP AT THE INTERSECTION  
OF RADER AVENUE AND SOUTH CHINA LAKE BOULEVARD**

**The Ridgecrest City Council resolves as follows:**

**Whereas**, increasing traffic volumes at the intersection of Rader Avenue and South China Lake Boulevard due to development in the southerly portions of the City of Ridgecrest have created a need for more traffic control at this intersection; and

**Whereas**, the City of Ridgecrest plans to install a traffic signal at the intersection of Rader Avenue and south China Lake Boulevard in the future when funding becomes available; and

**Whereas**, the need for more traffic control at the intersection of Rader Avenue and South China Lake Boulevard is such that establishment of a four way is necessary as an interim measure until such time as a traffic signal can be installed.

**Now, therefore**, the Ridgecrest City Council hereby authorizes the Director of Public Works to establish a four way stop at the intersection of Rader Avenue and south China Lake Boulevard using City of Ridgecrest labor and materials.




