

RESOLUTION NO. 02-17

**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL
APPROVING THE PURCHASE AND SOFTWARE UPDATE
MAINTENANCE FOR A DIGITAL RECORDING SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, The Police Department received \$100,000.00 from the State of California, through the Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Fund which was appropriated in the 2001-2002 adopted city budget, and;

WHEREAS, The Police Department is in need of a communications recording system, and;

WHEREAS, The Police Department evaluated four digital communications recording systems, and;

WHEREAS, Dictaphone, of Louisville, Kentucky, has the California Multiple Award Schedule bid (CMAS# 3-96-58-0020B) for their **Freedom** recording system, and;

WHEREAS, The City Council wishes to utilize the bids received by the State of California as provided for in section 15 of Resolution No. 89-120.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ridgecrest City Council does hereby authorize the following:

1. The award for the purchase of the Digital Communications Recording System and training, be given to Dictaphone of Louisville, Kentucky, in the amount of \$17,540.00, taxes included.
2. The award of three years of Software Update and Support Services be given to Dictaphone of Louisville, Kentucky, in the amount of \$7,190.00 at \$2,397.00 a year.
3. Authorize the City Manager or his designee to sign all contracts, papers and documents relating to the purchase and installation of the Freedom Communications Recording System.


