**RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS FOR THE HAZARD ELIMINATION SAFETY (HES) PROGRAM UNDER SECTION 152 (a), TITLE 23, UNITED STATES CODE (U.S.C.) FOR THE FOLLOWING PROJECT:**

**(Traffic Signal at China Lake Blvd and Ward Ave.)**

**WHEREAS**, the United States Congress has enacted the Transportation Equity Act for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century of 1998 requires that ten percent of the apportioned Surface Transportation Program (STP) funds be made available for safety programs as defined by Section 152 – Hazard Elimination Program of Title 23, United States Code

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Transportation has established the procedures and criteria for reviewing proposals and is required to submit to the California Department of Transportation Commission a list of recommended projects from which the recipients will be selected; and

**WHEREAS**, the applicant, if selected, will enter into an agreement with the State of California to carry out the transportation enhancement activities project;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED** that the Ridgecrest City Council:

- (1) Approves the filing of an application for Hazard Elimination Program for consideration for funding.
- (2) Certifies that said applicant will make adequate provisions for operation and maintenance of the project.




