

RESOLUTION NO. 02-37

**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS FOR "UNMET NEEDS" IN THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM.**

**WHEREAS**, during each year the City of Ridgecrest receives rural federal transit assistance under several sources of funding; Transportation Development Act Funds (TDA), Federal Transit Administration funds (FTA), and passenger fare revenues. Additionally, the City of Ridgecrest receives capital grant assistance funds, Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Program; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City Council will hold a Public Hearing to determine the "Unmet and Reasonable Transportation" needs.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the City Council that on May 15, 2002, at a regular meeting of the City Council, to hold a Public Hearing to receive public input about "Unmet and Reasonable Transportation" needs in the City of Ridgecrest and surrounding areas of Kern County.




