

RESOLUTION NO. 02-47

A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF KERN FOR THE DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF LAS FLORES AVENUE FROM BRADY STREET TO MAHAN STREET

WHEREAS, the Ridgecrest City Council authorizes the City Manager to enter into an agreement with the County of Kern for the design, construction, and maintenance of Las Flores Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Federal Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) funds are proposed for construction of Las Flores Avenue between Brady Street and Mahan Street (PROJECT) portions of which are located within the corporate boundaries of the CITY; and

WHEREAS, the County of Kern is willing to pay the CITY'S local agency share of the PROJECT which is approximately Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00) in exchange for the CITY assuming all maintenance, control, surveillance and protection of the traveling public on COUNTY portions of Las Flores Avenue from Mahan Street to approximately 2300 feet west of Mahan Street, at the location on the roadway coincident with westerly corporate boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Infrastructure Committee has researched and now recommends that this agreement with the County of Kern be entered into.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Ridgecrest City Council that the City will enter into an Agreement with the County of Kern for the Design, Construction and Maintenance of Las Flores Avenue as written in the agreement.
