**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST
ESTABLISHING UNMET AND REASONABLE TRANSIT NEEDS
FINDING**

WHEREAS, The transportation and Development Act Statues and Administrative Code for 1982 requires that before any allocation of Transportation Funds is made for a purpose not related to public transportation services that a public hearing be held to determine if there are Unmet Transit needs, that are reasonable to meet.

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held at the regular meeting of the City Council on May 15, 2002, for the purpose of receiving public testimony on Unmet and Reasonable Transit Needs; and

WHEREAS, public and Council testimony was received at the May 15, 2002 public hearing to which the following determination is made.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest as follows:

After consideration of all available information, including that presented at the public hearing, that there are **NO UNMET AND REASONABLE TRANSIT** needs in the area of the City of Ridgecrest, that are reasonable to meet.




