

RESOLUTION NO. 03-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL REALLOCATING PROPOSITION 12 FUNDS AND AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR DESIGN, BUILD AND CONSTRUCT SPORTS LIGHTING AT THE LEROY JACKSON SPORTS COMPLEX SOCCER FIELDS

The Ridgecrest City Council resolves as follows:

Section 1. On 23 January 2003 bids were received and opened for this project.

Section 2. The results of the bidding were as follows:

A-C Electric	\$210,000.00
Loop Electric	\$244,152.00
Budgeted Amount (Prop 12)	\$124,000.00

Section 3 The City of Ridgecrest Parks and Recreation Department received a grant from the State of California Parks and Recreation Department from Proposition 12 Funding for a number of projects which totals \$248,000. There are no matching funds required. These projects are as follows:


