

RESOLUTION NO. 03-49

A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING FTA SECTION 5311 GRANT FUNDS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS AND APPROVING CITY BUDGET AMENDMENT #2004-01 INCREASING APPROPRIATIONS AND ESTIMATED REVENUES IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest authorized the application for grant funds under FTA Section 5311 per Resolution 03-23; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest has been awarded funds for the purchase of one gasoline powered van pursuant to Department of Transportation standard agreement number 642066; and

WHEREAS, State of California contract #1-02-23-17 satisfies all appropriate bidding procedures pursuant to City and State requirements; and

WHEREAS, time is of the essence in the purchase of this vehicle for the continuing operation of the City's transit fleet; and

WHEREAS, funding is available to provide the local match (approximately \$13,063) in the City's transit reserve; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest has duly adopted its annual budget; and

WHEREAS, resolution 03-36 spells out the circumstances and procedures whereby total fund appropriations may be and can be increased; and

WHEREAS, certain increases in annual appropriations and estimated revenues to the budget require City Council Resolution prior to implementation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

1. City Council of the City of Ridgecrest accepts FTA Section 5311 Grant Funds authorized by Department of Transportation Standard Agreement number 642066;
2. City Manager is authorized to execute all appropriate documents and to make the purchase of the Handicapped-Equipped Van;
3. The Director of Finance is authorized to amend the budget as appropriate.


