

RESOLUTION NO. 04-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR FUNDS FOR THE CONGESTION MANAGEMENT AIR QUALITY (CMAQ) PROGRAM UNDER THE TRANSPORTATION EQUITY ACT FOR THE 21<sup>ST</sup> CENTURY (TEA-21) OF 1998 FOR THE FOLLOWING PROJECT: REEVES AVENUE PAVING CML-5385 (020)

**WHEREAS**, the United States Congress has enacted the Transportation Equity Act for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century of 1998, which is intended to provide federal dollars over a 6 year period as matching funds to local, state and federal agencies and nonprofit entities for Congestion Management Air Quality (CMAQ) projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Transportation has established the procedures and criteria for reviewing proposals and is required to submit to the California Department of Transportation Commission a list of recommended projects from which the recipients will be selected; and

**WHEREAS**, said procedures and criteria established by the California Department of Transportation resolution certifying the approval of application by the applicants governing body before submission of said application to the California Transportation Commission and the State of California; and

**WHEREAS**, the application contains assurances that the applicant must comply with; and

**WHEREAS**, the applicant, if selected, will enter into an agreement with the State of California to carry out the transportation enhancement activities project;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Ridgecrest City Council,

- (1) Approves the filing of an application for Congestion Management Air Quality Program for consideration for funding.
- (2) Certifies that said applicant will make adequate provisions for operation and maintenance of the project.
- (3) Appoints Harvey M. Rose, City Manager, or his designated representative, as agent of the City of Ridgecrest to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to application, agreements, amendments, payment request and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.


