

RESOLUTION NO. 04-38

A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL SUBMITTING TO THE VOTERS A QUESTION RELATING TO THE ADOPTION OF AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR AN ADDITIONAL THREE-QUARTER OF ONE PERCENT SALES TAX FOR GENERAL PURPOSES AT THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2004

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the laws relating to general law cities in the State of California, a General Municipal Election will be held on November 2, 2004, for the election of Municipal Officers; and

WHEREAS, the City Council also desires to submit to the voters at the election a question relating to the adoption of Ordinance No. 04-05 to provide for an additional three-quarter of one percent sales tax for general purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council, pursuant to its right and authority, does order submitted to the voters at the General Municipal Election the following question(s):

Shall the City of Ridgecrest Adopt Ordinance No. 04-05 To Provide For An Additional Three-Quarter Of One Percent Sales Tax For General Purposes.	Yes

SECTION 2. That the proposed complete text of the Ordinance submitted to the voters is attached as **Exhibit A**.

SECTION 3. That the ballots to be used at the election shall be in form and content as required by law.

SECTION 4. That the City Clerk is authorized, instructed and directed to procure and furnish any and all official ballots, notices, printed matter and all supplies, equipment and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the election.

SECTION 5. That in all particulars not recited in this Resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

SECTION 6. That notice of the time and place of holding the election is given and the City Clerk is authorized, instructed and directed to give further or additional notice of the election, in time, form and manner as required by law.

SECTION 7. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.

SECTION 8. This Resolution shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.


