

RESOLUTION NO. 04-62

A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR A TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT ACT (TEA) GRANT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF BICYCLE REST STATIONS AT FIVE LOCATIONS ALONG THE BOWMAN ROAD BIKE PATH

WHEREAS, applications for the three year cycle Transportation Enhancement Act (TEA) grants are coming due, and

WHEREAS, Transportation Enhancement Act (TEA) funded projects must meet a strict set of criteria and projects which benefit pedestrian and bicycle traffic qualify for TEA funding, and

WHEREAS, the Staff in consultation with the Infrastructure Committee developed a list of projects on the Bowman Road bicycle path which will benefit both pedestrian and bicycle users and will consist of landscaping, irrigation systems, benches and shade structures at the following locations:

<u>Location</u>	<u>Estimated Cost</u>
Bowman Road at China Lake Boulevard	\$55,900
Bowman Road at Downs Street	\$37,700
Bowman Road at Norma Street	\$55,900
Bowman Road at Gateway Street	\$37,700
Bowman Road at Sunland	<u>\$37,700</u>
Total	\$224,900

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest authorizes the Staff to apply for a Transportation Enhancement Act (TEA) grant to construct bicycle rest stations at five locations along the Bowman Road bike path.


