

RESOLUTION NO. 05-17

**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL
REESTABLISHING AN AD HOC SOLID WASTE ADVISORY
COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted a Source Reduction and Recycling Element on April 7, 1992; and

WHEREAS, that document called for the establishment of a solid waste committee, the Council advertised for interested and qualified citizens to serve on such a committee and established the committee by Resolution No. 93-56 on August 4, 1993 that subsequently was amended by Resolution No. 97-03 on February 19, 1997.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Resolutions 93-58 and 97-03 are rescinded and the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest hereby:

1. Reestablishes a five (5) member Citizens Ad Hoc Solid Waste Committee pursuant to the Source Reduction and Recycling Element; and
2. Declares that the committee's duties shall be generally to formulate review, and identify alternative for the implementation of the Source Reduction and Recycling Element and prepare recommendations for the City Council, Council Committees and Planning Commission addressing
 - Mandatory Community Collection and Recycling
 - Landfill Site permitting and extension
 - Commercial Waste, non-exclusive agreement and contracts; and
3. Defines the Committee to consist of five (5) members with each Council Member presenting a nominee for appointment by the Council as a whole; and
4. The Committee shall convene at an early opportunity and commence the work required by the Source Reduction and Recycling Element and the City Council;
5. The citizens serving on the Ad Hoc Solid Waste Advisory Committee shall receive no compensation but shall receive reimbursement for expenses incurred while on City business provided such expenses are authorized by the Council; and
6. The Community and Economic Development and Public Works Department shall assist the Committee in performance of its duties.
