**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING
THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE WORKFORCE INVESTMENT ACT
(WIA) GRANT AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, the County of Kern and the City Of Ridgecrest have entered into an agreement under the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Grant; and

WHEREAS, this resolution shall remain in effect until such time as it is amended or rescinded by Council resolution; and

WHEREAS, the County of Kern agrees to pay the City Of Ridgecrest a designated award to be determined annually through bid proposal to provide work experience to qualified youth and an appropriate adult supervisor to monitor the program; and

WHEREAS, the City Of Ridgecrest agrees to accept the designated award to pay grant expenditures as stipulated in the program description;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council authorize the City Manager to sign the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Grant Agreement.




