**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL SETTING
A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER COMMENTS AND
RECOMMENDATIONS FOR "UNMET NEEDS THAT ARE
REASONABLE TO MEET" IN THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION
SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, during each year the City of Ridgecrest receives rural federal transit assistance under several sources of funding; Transportation Development Act Funds (TDA), Federal Transit Administration Funds (FTA), and passenger fare revenues. Additionally, the City of Ridgecrest receives capital grant assistance funds, Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Program; and

WHEREAS, the Council will hold a Public Hearing to determine the "Unmet Needs that are Reasonable to Meet".

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Ridgecrest City Council that on March 21, 2007 at a regular meeting of the City Council, a Public Hearing will be held to receive public input about "Unmet and Reasonable to Meet Transportation Needs" in the City of Ridgecrest and surrounding areas of Kern County.




