

RESOLUTION NO. 07-65

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGECREST AWARDING A CONTRACT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$393,189.42 TO INTERNATIONAL PAVEMENT SYSTEMS FOR THE LANDSCAPING OF PORTIONS OF DOWNS STREET FROM INYOKERN ROAD TO CHINA LAKE BOULEVARD SUBJECT TO THE OUTCOME OF A FORMAL BID PROTEST BY ROCK BOTTOM LANDSCAPING

WHEREAS, bids were opened on 29 November 2007 for the landscaping of portions of Downs Street from Inyokern Road to China Lake Boulevard, and

WHEREAS, the results of the bidding are as follows:

WHEREAS, the bid required a base bid for landscaping and irrigation, and, an additive bid for stamped concrete, and

WHEREAS, International Pavement Systems was the low bidder for both the base bid and the total bid, and

WHEREAS, the total Transportation Enhancement Act (TEA) funds available for this project is \$573,383, and

WHEREAS, the total bid from International Pavement Systems exceeds the available funds but their base bid is less than the available funds, and

WHEREAS, a formal bid protest has been filed by Rock Bottom Landscaping alleging that International Pavement Systems did not comply with Disadvantage Business Enterprise (DBE) requirements for this project, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation (CALTRANS) has determined that DBE requirements do not apply to this project.

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest authorizes award of a contract in the amount of \$393,189.42 to International Pavement Systems for their base bid for landscaping and irrigation system on portions of Downs Street from Inyokern Road to China Lake Boulevard subject to resolution of the formal bid protest from Rock Bottom Landscaping.


