

RESOLUTION NO. 08-46

A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL PROHIBITING VEHICLES WITH A GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT RATING EXCEEDING 26,000 POUNDS FROM PARKING IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS ALONG STATE ROUTE 178 WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest adopted an ordinance prohibiting vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating in excess of 26,000 pounds from parking on residential streets; and

WHEREAS, residential districts abut State Route 178 within the city limits; and

WHEREAS, the California Vehicle Code Section 22506 allows local regulation of state highways within the City's jurisdiction upon written approval of the Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the City requested and received written consent from the Department of Transportation to regulate the parking along State Route 178 within the city limits.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest, does hereby prohibit vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating in excess of 26,000 pounds from parking in residential districts along State Route 178.




