

RESOLUTION NO. 08-65

**A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL
PROCLAIMING TERMINATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, in accordance with the proclamation of the Director of Emergency Services on July 29, 2008, and its ratification by the City Council on the July 30, 2008,

AS a result of conditions of extreme peril of the safety of persons and property caused by thunderstorms on July 20, 2008 that resulted in approximately 1.50 inches of rain in less than a two hour period that caused extreme flooding within the City of Ridgecrest. This flooding damaged multiple roadways, city owned vehicles, and an estimated 25 businesses and one residence; and,

WHEREAS, the situation resulting from said conditions of extreme peril is now deemed to be within the control of normal protective services, personnel, equipment and facilities of and within the CITY OF RIDGECREST;

NOW THEREFORE the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest does hereby proclaim the termination of said local emergency.


