

RESOLUTION NO. 08-88

A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL AMDENDING THE FIVE YEAR CONSOLIDATED PLAN AND THE ADOPTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2009-2010 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS

WHEREAS, the Kern County Department of Community Development (CDBG) requires that public comment be obtained for the Consolidated Plan and the Fiscal Year 2009-2010 Annual Action Programs; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest on December 3, 2008 held a duly noticed Public Hearing for the purpose of obtaining public input and identifying unmet needs of the community, and

WHEREAS, based on the public input received at this Public Hearing amendments to the plan were recommended as shown in Exhibit A attached hereto and made part of this resolution; and

WHEREAS, to implement the recommended plan, CDBG Fiscal Year 2009-2010 funds will need to be advanced, and on-going project #17071 is amended to reflect the increased increment of Norma Street between Church Avenue and Upjohn Avenue.

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest does hereby amend the Five Year Consolidated Plan and adopts the Fiscal Year 2009-2010 Annual Action Program for Community Development Programs and requests to advance funds from the Fiscal Year 2009-2010 City's fair share allocation.


