

RESOLUTION NO. 08-92

A RESOLUTION OF THE RIDGECREST CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE PRICE PROPOSAL FOR AN AUTOMATED DEMAND RESPONSE TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT SYSTEM, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT, AND APPROPRIATING RESERVE FUNDING IN THE SUM OF \$71,110.00

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest seeks to acquire an Automated Demand Response Transportation Management System to enhance transit services, and

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest has appropriated \$71,110.00 for this purchase, and

WHEREAS, \$31,616.00 will be reimbursed with FTA 5311 funds, and the total City cost (local match) of \$39,494 is to be paid from the transit fund reserve

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest authorized the issuance of a request for proposal for an Automated Demand Response Transportation Management System per the State of California guidelines, and

WHEREAS, three proposals were received and officially opened for examination and review, and

WHEREAS, all vendors met the requirements of the RFP and no terms for disqualification exist.

WHEREAS, all vendors presented their qualifications and were interviewed, and

WHEREAS, the proposals, presentations and interviews were evaluated, and

WHEREAS, staff has determined that the proposed price is fair and reasonable.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Ridgecrest hereby accepts the price proposal and awards the contract to RouteMatch; authorizes the City Manager to enter into the appropriate contract and agreements; and appropriates reserve funding in the sum of \$71,110.00


