

RESOLUTION NO. 09-81

**REQUEST FOR DETERMINATION OF WHICH TDA ARTICLE 3 BICYCLE LANE PROJECTS SHOULD MOVE FORWARD AND HOW THE SHORTFALL AMOUNTS WILL BE FUNDED.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Ridgecrest applied for TDA Article 3 grants for the construction and improvement of bicycle lane projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the applications were approved by the Kern Council of Governments (KCOG); and

**WHEREAS**, the projects were programmed for delivery implementation in the years of 2000, 2003, and 2004; and

**WHEREAS**, these projects did not move forward; and

**WHEREAS**, the KCOG Board mandated that all cities with aged projects both deliver and close by June 30, 2010 or de-obligate the funds; and

**WHEREAS**, The City was notified of this board action; and

**WHEREAS**, at the direction of the City Manager, the City Engineer prepared a cost analysis of the aged projects (refer to Attachment A); and

**WHEREAS**, The Infrastructure Committee determined that all of the projects should be pursued if shortfall funding is available;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest determined that all listed aged projects move forward and that the shortfall amounts be funded through RDA accounts.




