A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE CONSULTING FIRM OF PROVOST AND PRITCHARD AS THE CITY ADVISOR and OWNER'S REPRESENTATIVE FOR THE NEW WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY.

WHEREAS, the City of Ridgecrest is proposing to have a new Wastewater Treatment Facility completed no later than December 31, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the City Advisor is an integral partner to ensure the successful outcome of a Design-Build contract; and

WHEREAS, proposals were received and officially opened for examination and review; and

WHEREAS, the selection committee reviewed and analyzed the proposals; and

WHEREAS, the selection committee interviewed the top ranked firms; and

WHEREAS, the selection committee selected Provost and Pritchard as the consultant best qualified to provide this service;


WHEREAS, staff entered into negotiations with the firm, Provost and Pritchard and this resulted in a professional services agreement for City Council approval;
