A RESOLUTION REQUESTING CALIFORNIA PUBLIC EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT SYSTEM BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION APPROVAL TO EXTEND THE TEMPORARY EMPLOYMENT OF INTERIM CITY MANAGER HARVEY M. ROSE

WHEREAS the position of Ridgecrest City Manager is currently vacant, and

WHEREAS retired, former City Manager Harvey M. Rose agreed to return as Interim City Manager to manage City operations and assist in the recruitment of a permanent replacement, and

WHEREAS a new, permanent City Manager has been selected and employed effective August 1, 2010, and

WHEREAS the Ridgecrest City Council wish Harvey M. Rose to continue working full time until August, 1, 2010, and be available on an hourly basis thereafter at the discretion of the City Council and new City Manager, and

WHEREAS, Harvey M. Rose is nearing the 960-hour work limitation for calendar year 2010 as permitted in Government Code section 21221(h).

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Ridgecrest, California, pursuant to Government Code section 2122(h), request approval of the California Public Employee Retirement System Board of Administration to allow extension of employment of Harvey M. Rose beyond the 960-hour limitation in calendar year 2010.


