1. **CALL TO ORDER**
The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m.
2. **APPROVAL OF AGENDA**
The agenda was approved.
3. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES December 12, 2006**

5. **DISCUSSION ITEMS:**
 - a. China Lake Blvd. – Delineators. CE Pollock provided an update on the status of the delineators in front of Rite-Aid and the Mervyn's shopping center. City would need 300-400 to put delineators up to Felspar; they're about \$30-40 each. The committee directed staff to research possible grants for a median.
 - b. Residential Street Lighting (older areas of town) – CE Pollock provided history and how program works. Property owners pay the cost to put light in, SCE puts the light in, and City pays for the electricity. The committee directed staff to create a brochure.
 - c. Proposition 1B – CM Rose provided an update. Schedule is unknown; It will be awhile before we see any money. The committee discussed street issues and options to using the expected 1B funds. Committee requested Sunland be considered.
 - d. Street Maintenance and Repair Program residential – Committee continued discussion of street issues and discussed street sweeping. Chair Morgan asked the committee to consider a policy where neighborhood pays for street sweeping.
6. **DIRECTOR'S REPORT**
Council Impact Plan update – no new information available.

Reviewed with the committee a list of equipment requested for the streets department and cost. CDBG project bid opening was January 4th. The Reeves, Graaf, Mahan project is done.
