On 05/18/2007 at about 1350 hours Officers of the Ridgecrest Police Department responded to the report of male suspect pounding on the door of a residence. Upon arrival they were told that the male suspect, HAGEWOOD, had left the scene in a vehicle. HAGEWOOD did not live at the residence, though his former girlfriend did. An area check was conducted though the suspect was not located in the Domestic Dispute.

At about 1440 hours victim's inside the home again called 911 to advise that the suspect had returned. During the call, Dispatcher Turbide could hear and was told of a physical attack by the suspect above, as he forced his way into the home. The caller advised the suspect was possibly armed.

Officer's arrived on scene only to find that the suspect had again fled in a vehicle. The suspect was spotted fleeing the scene, driving erratically. Officers overtook the suspect at the intersection of W. Ridgecrest Blvd and Norma St. There he was taken into custody during a high risk/ felony stop without injury. Inside the vehicle, two knives were recovered.

The suspect was transported and booked at Kern County Jail/ Ridgecrest, where at the time of this press release he remains in custody.
