TYPE OF INCIDENT: Felony Warrant Arrest/ 148(a) PC-Resist arrest

LOCATION OCCURRED: 200 W. Perdew Ave
SUSPECTS: BOZEK, Warren Dean- 40 yoa-Idaho resident.

On 11/14/2007 at about 0955 hours, Ridgecrest Police Officers and Detectives responded to the address above, after the location of the wanted felony suspect, BOZEK was confirmed. Upon arrival Police surrounded the residence and found a aggressive pit bull dog at the location. Before officers could make contact BOZEK fled from inside the residence, running through the backyard.

BOZEK was confronted as he attempted to jump the rear fence line. As he attempted to run back towards the house he was shot with a Taser device. Additional officers were able to move in to the rear yard, continuing to fend off the vicious dog. Parties from inside the home restrained the animal and BOZEK was taken into custody by Officer Ryan MARRONE. BOZEK had been at large and on the run for over two years. Neither BOZEK or any officers or detectives were injured in the arrest.

BOZEK was transported to Ridgecrest Regional hospital then to Kern County Jail where he was booked on the outstanding warrant and open resisting arrest charges. He remains in custody.

BOZEK was recently featured as one of Ridgecrest Most Wanted suspects.
