TYPE OF INCIDENT: HS 11377(a) – Possession of Controlled Substance and PC 148(a)(1) – Resist, Obstruct, Delay Peace Officer.

LOCATION: 300 block of W. Robertson Ave.

SUSPECT: Williams, Timothy Robert (35 year old Ridgecrest resident).

RESUME OF INCIDENT

On May 17, 2013 Officer's Kyle Cushman and Ritchey Garibay responded to a residence in the 300 block of W. Robertson Ave. to conduct a probation search. While on-scene, they contacted Timothy Williams, whom is on PRCS (Post Release Community Supervision). Williams was asked by the officers if he had anything illegal on his person, at which time Williams took his hand out of view and began reaching for his pocket. Williams was ordered to show his hand, but refused to do so. Fearing Williams was possibly trying to retrieve a weapon, the officers took hold of him and a short struggle ensued. During the struggle, Williams threw two bindles onto the ground. He was subsequently arrested without further incident. A search of the bindles revealed approximately 10 grams of suspected methamphetamine.

Williams was arrested for the listed charges and booked at the Kern County Jail. His bail was set at \$15,000.00
