TYPE OF EVENT: Unsafe and Dangerous Building Abated in Ridgecrest Neighborhood

LOCATION: 427 W. Robertson Ave.

For several years, the property located at 427 W. Robertson Ave. has been abandoned and on several occasions, neighbors have reported that transients have been seen inside the residence. Attempts to locate the property owner revealed the property was owned by a bank that was closed by the FDIC approximately five years ago. On January 27, 2015, the issue was brought before the Planning Commission who authorized abatement of the property, which included the boarding up of the main structure and garage, and the cleanup of trash, junk and debris on the property. On March 10, 2015, the abatement was completed using Ridgecrest Tax Allocation Bond funds.
